



Camp Wild Oaks Summer Programs Registration Policies:

Registration Process:

Registration happens online and over the phone with the Oak Hill School Auxiliary Program Manager.

Registration and payment for Camp Wild Oaks is only accepted through the Oak Hill Auxiliary Programs/Camp Wild Oaks Site Activeworks site. Parents can go on the Camp Wild Oaks webpage at oakhillschool.net/CampWildOaks to find the link to register for their chosen camp class.

Any of the registration buttons on our program pages will lead parents to our Activeworks portal where they can register for any of our camps/camp classes. Once Parents select the camp class they want, the system will lead them through registering for that camp class.

NOTE: If you already have an account with Activeworks, please sign in with that account. If you have an account please do not create a new one when asked to sign in. the forgot password prompt should help you recover your account if you do not remember it..

Who Can Register:

Our Camp Wild Oaks Enrichment Camp is open to the public! Anyone can register!

Camp Class Registration Capacities:

All of our camp classes have both minimum and maximum capacities.

Minimum Capacity: the minimum number of students that need to be registered for our camp classes to run. For most of our camp classes we need at least 4 students registered for the camp class to run. There are some, however, that require a higher

number of campers registered to run. These minimum numbers can be found in the descriptions of the camp classes.

It is expensive in both time and money to run our camp classes, and we need to make sure that it is worth our time, that of the hired instructors, and that of the students registered.

****Aftercare does not have a minimum capacity as we are always open for drop-ins and emergency after-camp stays.**

If one of our camp classes does not meet its minimum capacity, it will be canceled 7 days before it is due to start, according to our cancelation and refund policy

Maximum Capacity: All of our camp classes have a maximum capacity, determined either by the fire code room capacity, our instructor's legal supervision capacity, or COVID-19 cohort limits. In some emergency situations, these maximum capacities can be exceeded with accommodations, but, in most cases these maximum limits are absolute.

****For Aftercare our maximum capacity is 20 students. If this number is exceeded in an emergency situation after school, accommodations will be made.**

Waitlists: If our classes meet their maximum capacity before a family can register, they will be placed on a waiting list. Families with children on our camp class waiting lists will be selected for entrance into the camp classes if and when registered students cancel their registration.
